

## League Secretary Information

*It is the team captain/league secretary's responsibility to make sure first and last names of bowlers are written on the recaps.*

**I. Averages** – available on gcvusbc.com, bowl.com, USBC app, and centers have hard copies.

### II. Membership Fees

1. Standard fee \$19. Mark \$19 amount paid through this league, sign and give them the temporary membership receipt. If not paying in your league write 0 or draw a line.
2. Local Only \$5. Bowlers paid in other Iowa association. Paid in other state add \$1 + \$5 local. Please get their Bowler ID# as bowlers use the same National ID# in all association
3. WBA & BA - Women that want to bowl both WBA and BA state tournaments - pay standard \$19 + \$1=\$20.
4. Collegiate bowlers need to pay Local (\$5), state (\$1).

Every bowler that bowls in your league must submit an application card. Additional blank membership application cards are available at the centers. Please make sure the league name is included.

**III. Reprint membership cards** at [www.bowl.com](http://www.bowl.com), under “Find a”, select “member” from pull down list.

**IV. League Rules** – Submit a copy of your rules to the center and association office.

**V. No later than after your 2<sup>ND</sup> League session**, please submit:

1. Membership application cards (alphabetically helps) for every bowler who bowls/subs in your league. It is your responsibility as league secretary to make sure the card is complete.
2. The League Application – must be complete.
3. The Greater Cedar Valley League Dues worksheet.
4. A check for the amount of fees owed payable to ‘Greater Cedar Valley USBC’. You can deposit the membership fees with in-house banking, but you **MUST ARRANGE FOR THE CHECK TO BE WRITTEN** when you are ready to submit to the association office. Please, do **NOT** use in house banking for bowlers who pay after you have submitted the initial application and monies.

### V. Awards

1. USBC High Score Applications (300, 800) - All should be submitted to the association office.
2. \*GCV Multiple 800, 300 awards - one per lifetime acrylic award or \$20 donation to youth scholarship fund. First multiple each year will receive a \$1 center buck.
2. \*GCV 1<sup>st</sup> 600, 700, 11 In a Row - one per lifetime award. 11 In a Row-acrylic award or \$20 donation to youth scholarship fund.
3. \*League Achievement Awards - submitted by the centers. \$1 certificate to be used at the center where the award was earned. Expires Sept. 30. One award per category per season.
4. \*Sour Apple Award – available for all association members. Leave the 5-7-10 and have a witness.
5. \*Iowa State USBC Women’s Bowling Association 275+/300 Game/700/800 Series Award Application should be submitted immediately using form, email or a note.

WBA (Women) – Waterloo – February 24 – May 6, 2018 **GCV yellow entries go to Loretta, not the state.**

Midwest (Women) – Green Bay, Wisconsin – Fri-Sun, June 2 – July 1, 2018
