- DATES:** January 25 & 26  
**CENTER:** Maple Lanes  
**ENTRIES:** Open: December 1 and close January 18  
**LATE ENTRIES:** accepted at discretion of the tournament manager.  
**EVENTS:** Doubles (2 games) - 2 bowlers, Boys, Girls, or Mixed (\$6 per bowler/\$12 per pair)  
 Singles (2 games) - \$6 per bowler.  
 Optional All Events - \$1  
**HDCP:** 100% of the difference between the bowlers average and 100.  
**FEES:** \$6.00 per event per bowler. Two event total per person \$12, \$13 with all Events.

**RULES**

- All entrants may bowl ONE time in each event and must be bowling in a bumper league.
- All bowlers must check in 1/2 hour before scheduled time to bowl. Late bowlers will receive 0 pin fall for frames missed.
- Bowlers will use the GCV USBC certified average posted January 1. Bowlers with fewer than 8 games at the time entries close will use previous season yearbook average. If none, then an assigned average of 80 will be used.
- Medals will be awarded to the first three places in all of the events. Medals will be awarded for the individual High Handicap series in the doubles event.
- If you need to bowl at times not listed please contact the tournament manager, Loretta Wander, 277-6745, to see if lanes are available.
- NO REFUNDS AFTER CLOSING DATE.
- Once bowling has begun, be prepared to bowl when it is your turn. 0 score is recorded for frames missed.
- Dress Code Rule - Please wear an appropriate bowling shirt with no objectionable sayings of graphics. Jeans may be worn as long as they are worn appropriately, have no holes or are frayed. No hats are to worn unless for medical reasons. Swearing, inappropriate gestures and abusing equipment will not be tolerated.
- Cell phones, iPods and all electronic devices must be turned off during competition.
- Substitutes or absentee scores may be used in an emergency for doubles only. (average minus 10 pins + handicap)
- No use of tobacco, alcohol or vaping by Youth Bowling participants OR ADULTS during the tournament.
- Photo Release - Staff and volunteers often take photographs during events. The photos may be used in our website and social medias accounts.
