DATES: January 25 and 26

CENTER: Maple Lanes

ENTRIES: Open: December 1, Close January 18

Team Divisions: Bantam (11 & Under - total of ages 46 or less), Junior (12-14 - total of ages 47 to 58), Senior (15 & Over - total of ages 59 & Over)

Doubles event: Bantam (total of ages 23 or less), Junior (total of ages 24 to 29), Senior (total of 30 &.over)

LATE ENTRIES: accepted at discretion of the tournament manager.

EVENTS: Team - 4 bowlers - Boys, Girls, or Mixed. (\$9 per bowler/\$36 per team)

Doubles - 2 Bowlers - Boys, Girls, or Mixed (\$9 per bowler/\$18 per set)

Singles - Boys, Girls. (\$9 per bowler)

Optional All Events - Boy, girl. (\$1 per bowler)

Optional Scratch Singles and All Events \$5, must be entered in all events and singles to include scratch events.

HDGP: 100% of the difference between the bowlers average and 210.

FEES: \$9 per event per bowler, 3 event total per person \$27, with All Events \$28, with optional scratch Sgls and AE \$33.

RULES

1. **TEAM:** Multiple participation allowed in the team event only. At least two members of the lineup must be different on each entry.
DOUBLES/SINGLES: A bowler must enter both doubles and singles. Doubles will be bowled first.
All EVENTS: First score bowled in an event will count for All Events.
A bowler may also bowl as a substitute in an emergency, but the first score bowled will count for All Events.
2. Team and Double Divisions will be determined by the sum/average of the ages. No change in division after bowling begins each shift. AGE AS OF AUGUST 1 will be used.
3. All bowlers must check in 1/2 hour before scheduled time to bowl. **Late bowlers** will receive 0 pinfall for frames missed.
4. Bowlers will use the GCV USBC certified average posted January 1 in a regular league. Bowlers with fewer than 12 games at the time entries close will use the previous season yearbook average. If none, the following averages will be used: 11 & under assigned 110, 12-14 assigned 150 and 15 & over assigned 180.
5. Medals will be awarded to first three places in each Age Division for each event, including All Events. Medals will be awarded for the individual High Handicap series in each age division for both boys and girls in the team event.
6. If you need to bowl at times not listed please contact the tournament manager, Loretta Wander, 277-6745, to see if lanes are available.
7. **NO REFUNDS AFTER CLOSING DATE.**
8. Once bowling has begun, be prepared to bowl when it is your turn. 0 score is recorded for frames missed.
9. **Dress Code Rule** - Please wear your bowling t-shirt or an appropriate shirt with no objectionable sayings or graphics. Jeans may be worn as long as they are worn appropriately and have no holes or are frayed. No hats are to be worn unless for medical reason. Swearing, inappropriate gestures and abusing equipment will not be tolerated.
10. Cell phones, iPods and all electronic devices must be turned off during competition.
11. A substitute or absentee scores may be used in an emergency. (Average minus 10 pins + handicap)
12. No use of tobacco, alcohol or vaping by youth bowling participants OR ADULTS during the tournament.
13. **Photo Release-** Staff and volunteers often take photographs during events. The photos may be used in our website and social media accounts.

Please talk to your parents and your team members about bowling in this Tournament.
If you need bowlers to bowl with you for Doubles or to make up a team - ask your coach to help you.
